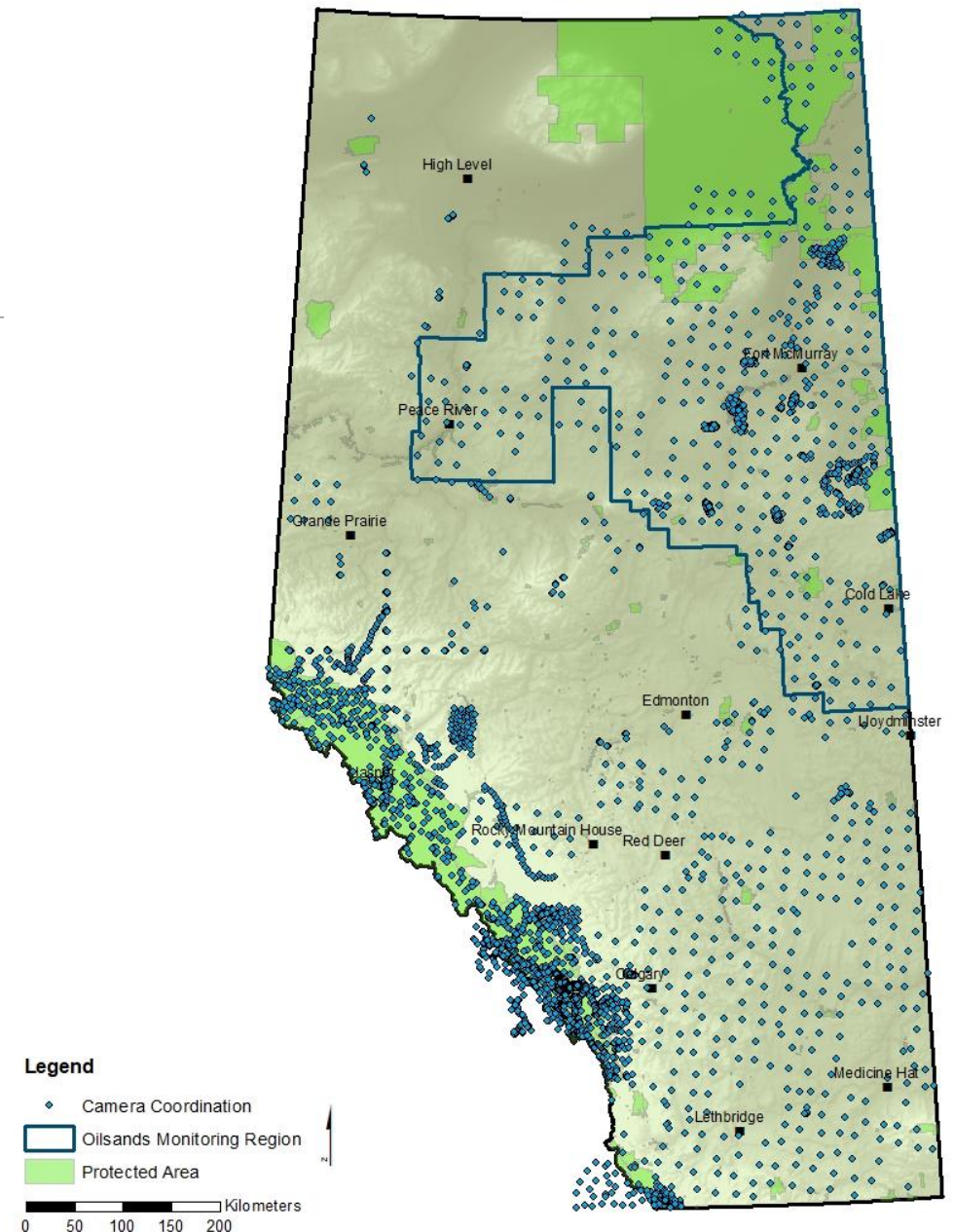

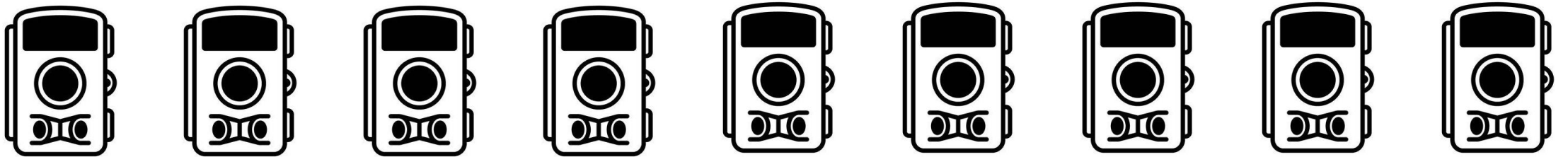
Collection of (some) camera locations

- Approx 30% of >120 projects have shared data



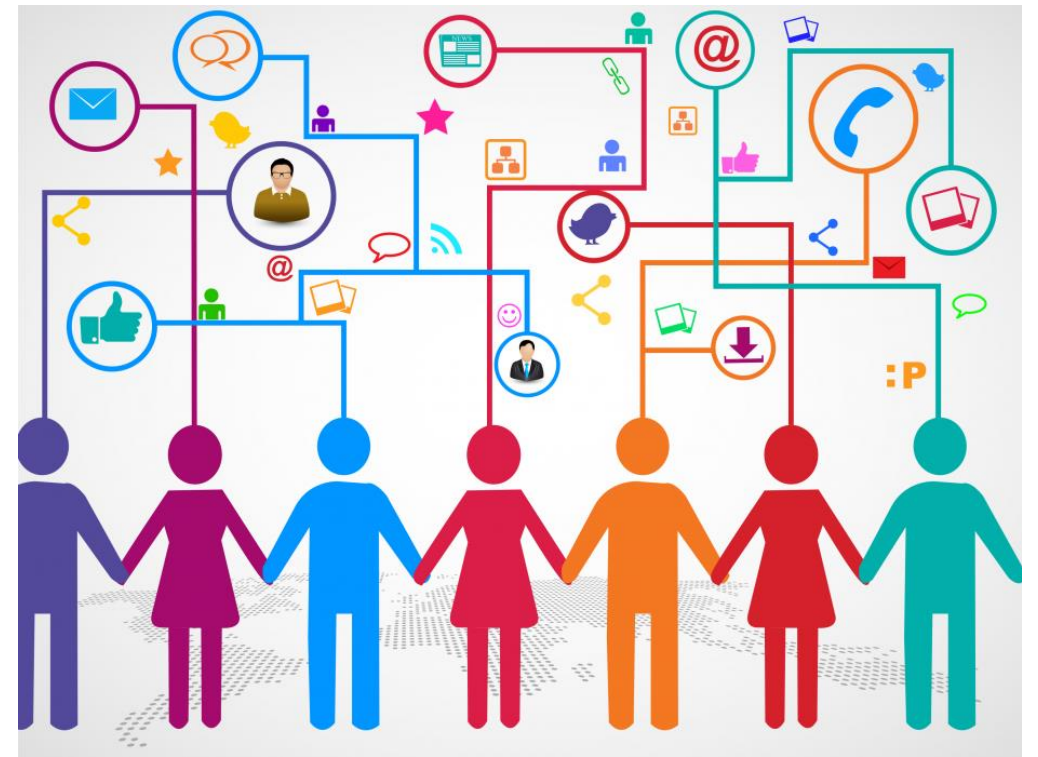
Remote Camera Coordinator

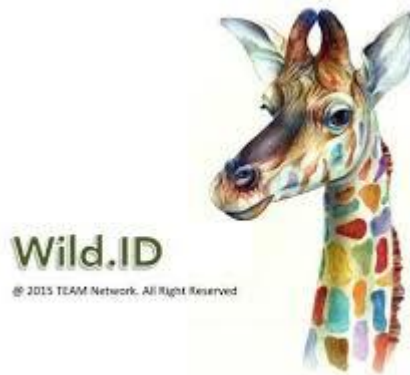

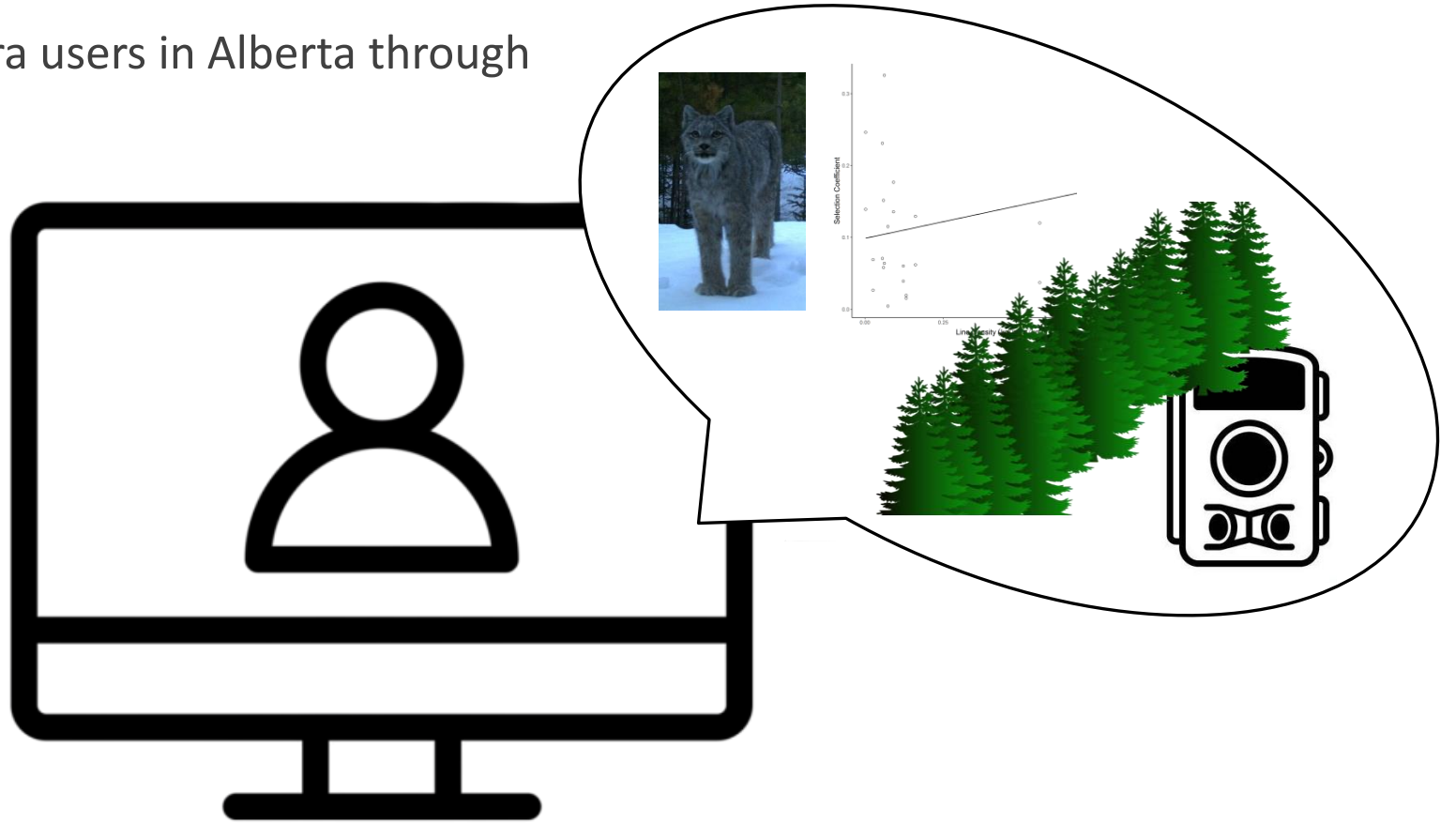
